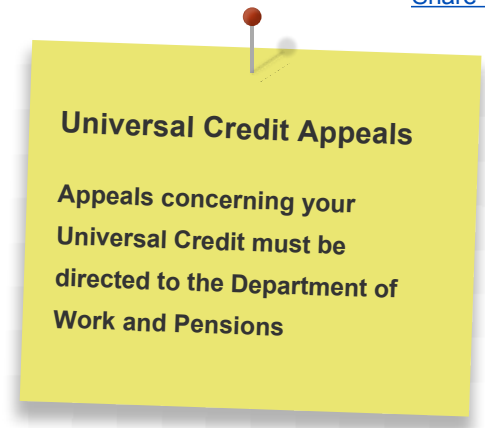
If we have made a decision about your Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support that you do not agree with, you, or any person affected (see below), can formally dispute this.

You can:

- ask us to revise our decision or
- appeal against our decision to an independent appeal tribunal.

You can dispute any matter concerning a claim for Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support, for example:

- the amount of benefit payable
- the rent eligible for benefit
- the calculation of your income
- the calculation and recovery of an overpayment
