Following the endorsement from the Licensing Committee - Hertsmere Borough Council's Licensing Department are now publishing their proposed Statement of Licensing Policy.

The current statement of Licensing Policy is for the period between 2017 - 2022 and the proposed statement of Licensing Policy is for the period between 2023 – 2028.

As per Section 5 of the Licensing Act 2003 - The Council are required by law to prepare and publish a Statement of Licensing every five years. A Statement of Licensing stipulates how we as the Council's Licensing Authority will exercise our functions under the Licensing Act 2003.
