### Provision of regulated entertainment

Anything similar to live music, recorded music or dance performances

- Boxing or wrestling entertainment
- Dance performances
- Films
- Indoor sporting events
- Live and recorded music
- Plays

### Provision of late night refreshment

#### Supply of alcohol

- Clubs supplying alcohol
- Shops selling of alcohol

#### Types of licence

A personal licence is granted to an individual, which permits the sale of alcohol in conjunction with a premises licence.
