CORONAVIRUS PROJECTS GRANTS 2020

As a result of the coronavirus pandemic and the impact it is having on our residents and voluntary and charity organisations, we decided that our community grants scheme for this financial year would be split into two funding streams. The first round was for those voluntary sector organisations who are facing financial difficulty.

This second round will be providing larger grants of up to £5,000 to community organisations that have adapted their services to support people during the pandemic.

Organisations must demonstrate they are actively involved in helping the community deal with the impact of coronavirus. This could, for example, be projects which support the wellbeing of vulnerable groups, debt and financial advice or activity which has a positive impact on community and individual wellbeing more generally.

Any properly constituted group, club or organisations which are based in, or operate for the benefit of, residents of Hertsmere can apply for up to £5,000.

Applications will be considered on a first come first served basis until the funding for this round has been fully allocated.
