This information is used when implementing and making decisions on new policies and procedures across the council's functions.

As part of our duty under the [Equality Act 2010](#), we have published our response to the Public Sector Equality Duty. This response includes a document [Knowing Our Community](#) which contains information we currently hold on our community. This document is updated in January each year. We have also produced a report in response to the [2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation](#).
