The electrical installation shall be inspected at least once in every five years, or such lesser period as considered appropriate to the individual case, by a competent electrical engineer

appointed by or on behalf of the licensee of the premises and a certificate stating the condition of the installation shall after each inspection, be forwarded to the Council by or on behalf of the licensee of the premises.

The number of persons (excluding staff and attendants) to be allowed at any one time in the licensed hall area shall not exceed 150 persons.
