No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence

- 1) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of it or,
- 2) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

1. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person as an ancillary to his meal or with a take away meal. Suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (including drinking water) shall be equally available for consumption with or otherwise as an ancillary to meals served in the licensed premises.
2. On or before commencing employment all managers and staff shall receive training and are required to understand licensing law.
3. In relation to persons thought to be under the age of 18, I.D. must be required and if not provided or if there is any doubt about the I.D. then the service of alcohol must be refused.
4. The fire alarm system and fire extinguishers shall be maintained in full working order.
5. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
