Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

1. Staff shall receive training in relevant licensing law and records of training shall be held at the premises.
2. A "Panic Button" alarm system shall be installed and maintained.
3. Service shall be declined to persons who are or appear to be drunk.
4. Anybody who appears to be under the age of 18 shall be asked to provide evidence of proof of age. The only forms of proof of age to be accepted shall be: Passport, Photographic Driving Licence or PASS approved I.D. card.
