Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence

1. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of it or,
2. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

Staff will be trained on the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 when they are recruited and given training in "drugs awareness" as part of their induction.

The DPS must be a member of Bushey Pubwatch were active.

Function Room Bookings are limited to 80 persons.

The capacity of the whole premise including staff and performers must not exceed 200.

Kitchen extract filters must be cleaned at least once a week to minimise the impact of cooking smells to neighbours.

Photographic Identification must be required to be shown by all persons thought to be under the age of 20 years of age.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after hearing by the licensing authority.

1. Ingress and egress notwithstanding, all external doors and windows to the premises are to be kept closed during any regulated entertainment.
2. All external doors are to be fitted with automatic door closers. Where an external door is served by a lobby, the door closer may be fitted to the internal lobby door.
3. Amplified music and/or speech external to the premises is not permitted.
4. Prominent, clear and legible notices are to be displayed within the premises and at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly. The signs should highlight the noise-sensitive nature of the alleyway between the High Road and The Lake.
5. The tipping of bottles into receptacles external to the premises must not take place between 21:00 and 09:00 hours.
6. The use of areas external to the premises for the consumption of alcohol, other refreshment or food, must cease by 23:00 hours Monday to Saturday and 22:30 hours Sunday.
7. A noise-limiting device is to be used for regulated entertainment that involves amplified music and/or amplified voice. The levels of the noise-limiting device are to be set in agreement with the Environmental Health Unit.
8. Noise from any regulated entertainment should not be audible at nearby noise-sensitive premises.
9. Unaccompanied children under 18 shall not be permitted on the premises, including the garden area, at any time Children under 14 shall not be permitted on the premises, including the garden area after 19:00 (Sunday to Thursday) or 21:00

(Friday and Saturday) unless accompanied by a responsible adult and partaking in substantial meal.

10. Payment at the premises shall be by cash, cheque with guarantee card, acceptable valid credit card, or on the prior provision of an acceptable and valid debit or credit card.
11. Patrons shall not be admitted to the premises after 23:30 (Sunday to Thursday) and 24:00 (Friday and Saturday).
12. An additional Personal Licence holder shall be employed at the premises before 24 November 2005, and another as soon as practicable after that. At least one of the Personal Licence Holders should be present when the premises are open between 23:00 hours and closing time.
13. To undertake to arrange a liaison group with local residents and local wards Councillor to meet on a regular basis at a mutual date and time for all.
