Alcohol must not be served to anyone suspected of being drunk or under age.

ID cards must be given to all staff, including volunteers.

Any person considered to be causing a nuisance must be escorted off the premises.

All games and activity areas must be supervised by a responsible.

Children must be accompanied at all times by a parent or responsible adult.
