2. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

1. All staff shall be instructed about the rules relating to the supply of alcohol and a record of such training shall be maintained in documentary form.

2. In relation to persons who appear to be under the age of 18, identification (I.D) shall be required such as a UK driver's licence, passport or "PASS" approved I.D. Card. If such I.D is not provided or if there is any doubt about the I.D. then the service of alcohol shall be refused.
