Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence

1. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of it or,

2. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

1. A proof of age scheme, such as Challenge 21, shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence or passport.

2. Persons under the age of 16 shall not be permitted to enter or remain upon the premises after 21:00 hours unless they are accompanied by a responsible adult and are dining.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after hearing by the licensing authority.

1. Break bar and crash bar final fire exits shall be maintained and kept unobstructed.

2. The emergency lighting of fire exits shall be of the fully maintained type.

3. The electrical installation shall be inspected at least once a year by a competent electrical engineer appointed by or on behalf of the premises licence holder, and a certificate stating the condition of the installation shall after each inspection be forwarded to the licensing authority by or on behalf of the premises licence holder.

4. All external doors shall be fitted with automatic door closers. Where an external door is served by a lobby, the door closer may be fitted to the internal lobby door.

5. Amplified music and/or speech external to the premises is not permitted.

6. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

7. The tipping of bottles into receptacles external to the premises shall not take place between 19.00 hours and 09.00 hours.

8. The use of areas external to the premises shall cease by 23.00 hours Monday to Saturday and 22.00 hours on Sunday.

9. All external doors shall be fitted with acoustic seals and threshold strips
