1.0	<u>Welcomes and apologies</u>
1.1	The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and gave a special welcome to the guest speakers.
1.2	The Chairman advised the group that Rev Richard Leslie will be replaced by Lewis Osbourne on the LSP board. The Chairman thanked Rev Richard Leslie for all of his work with Hertsmere Forum of Faiths and the LSP.
1.3	The Chairman also thanked Councillor Brenda Batten for all her of contributions to the LSP and for chairing the Health and Wellbeing Partnership for many years. Councillor Batten has stepped down as Portfolio Holder for Leisure, Culture and Health. Councillor Caroline Clapper will be the new Portfolio Holder for Leisure, Culture and Health and representative for the LSP.
1.4	In addition the Chairman welcomed new members Lydia Massey who will be replacing Debbie Barker, Councillor Terry Douris who will be replacing Councillor Teresa Heritage and Charles Shun who will be replacing Jeremy Green.
2.0	<u>Minutes of the previous meeting and matters arising</u>
2.1	The minutes of the previous meeting were agreed as a true record and no further updates were required.

3.0	<u>Community Strategy Draft</u>
3.1	Following the LSP in March and the Community Strategy Review Workshop in February, a new Community Strategy has been drafted for the next four years.
3.2	The review of the previous strategy has enabled the partnership to refocus and take account of new government policies. The strategy's vision, priorities and themes continue to be relevant and important to the partnership, though ideas and comments are welcome on this.
3.3	There is still broad representation from different organisations on the LSP board which is reviewed in line with the Community Strategy. If you would like to recommend a new partner to join the board, please let Rebecca know.
3.4	Rebecca invited partners to read the Community Strategy 2017-2021 Draft (please see attached) and asked them to send comments to Rebecca.Young@hertsmere.gov.uk by 15 July.
4.0	<u>End of year crime figures</u>
4.1	Chief Inspector Stephen O'Keeffe talked through a presentation. Please see attached.
4.2	Dr Kate Page mentioned that patients have been discussing issues of anti-social behaviour (ASB) in the local area and that during the last six weeks, it has been particularly prevalent. They fear that ASB will get worse over the summer holiday period.
4.3	Stephen O'Keeffe mentioned that they have seen a displacement of ASB after some dispersal orders were put into place around Borehamwood McDonalds. There has since been arrests and there are a number of key individuals under Community Protection Notices or on bail, whom they believe were responsible for the ASB. During the summer holidays the Constabulary will look at trends of ASB and respond appropriately.
4.4	Stuart Nagler asked if the number of fraud related crimes are recorded in Hertsmere. Stephen O'Keeffe answered that most offences are reported straight to Action Fraud.
4.5	Councillor Pervez Choudhury commented on some of the work the council has done with regards to crime and disorder. Some training was recently held covering ASB Powers. There will also be training for staff on modern slavery and human trafficking.
4.6	Councillor Pervez Choudhury also asked what was being done about the decrease in outcome rates in some of the crime types.
4.7	Stephen O'Keeffe answered that there has been further investment in the Domestic Abuse Investigation Safeguarding Unit (DAISU) and there is covert operations underway to tackle issues.
4.8	The Chairman thanked Stephen O'Keeffe for his presentation and the Constabulary for their continued hard work.

4.9	The Chairman informed the group of Hertfordshire County Council's draft Hate Crime Strategy which is currently out for consultation.
