## **Regularisation charges**

Charges are calculated in accordance with the Hertsmere Borough Council Building Regulation Current Charges Scheme. They are payable with the application and are not subject to VAT. It is therefore important that sufficient detail about the project be included to avoid the need for further applications. Where the incorrect amount has been submitted the regularisation application cannot be treated as a valid submission and will prevent the issue of a Regularisation Certificate.
