**Inspector's proposed Main Modifications**  
**Hertsmere Borough Council's proposed Additional Modifications,**  
**proposed changes to the submitted Policies Map, and**  
**addendum to the submitted Sustainability Appraisal.**  
**CONSULTATION**

The appointed Inspector for the SADM Policies Plan public examination has now published a list of proposed Main Modifications to the submitted Plan which he considers are required to make the plan sound. There is now an opportunity to comment on these proposed Main Modifications before the Inspector issues his final report. The Inspector will set out the reasons for his proposed modifications in his final report.

The proposed Main Modifications have arisen following the public hearings which were held in April 2016 as part of the examination. To accompany the Main Modifications the Council has also updated its Sustainability Appraisal of the Plan.

The Plan itself has already been the subject of several stages of public consultation commencing in 2014 on a draft Plan and subsequently on an amended version of the Plan which was submitted for public examination in November 2015. Changes proposed to the version of the Policies Map that accompanied the submitted SADM Policies Plan are also included in this consultation. These changes are principally proposed either in response to representations on the submitted Policies Map or are linked to proposed modifications to the SADM Plan itself.

Representations must consider whether these changes satisfactorily address matters of soundness and/or legal compliance, and should be made on the official response form (which is available on the Council's website, with paper copies available on demand). All comments received relating to these proposed modifications will be passed to the Inspector for his consideration. Representations on other parts of the SADM Policies Plan will not be considered by the Inspector.

In addition to the above, the Council is proposing 'Additional Modifications' to the SADM Policies Plan to include or update factual text or to correct errors. These Additional Modifications do not materially affect the policies in the Plan. The Council is not obliged to consult on these proposed Additional Modifications, but considers it good practice to do so. A schedule these Additional Modifications is therefore available for comment.
