**THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (ELDON AVENUE, BOREHAMWOOD) (PERMIT
HOLDER PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2016 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2017**

Hertsmere Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council (“the County Council”) under Section 19 of the Local Authorities (Arrangements for the Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2012 in exercise of the powers on the said County Council by Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall may be cited as The Hertsmere Borough Council (Eldon Avenue, Borehamwood) (Permit Holder Parking) Order 2016 (Amendment No.2) Order 2017, hereinafter referred to as “this Order” and shall come into operation on xxxxxxxx 2017.
2. The Hertsmere Borough Council (Eldon Avenue, Borehamwood) (Permit Holder Parking Places) Order 2016 shall be amended as follows:

Schedule 2 to The Hertsmere Borough Council (Eldon Avenue, Borehamwood) (Permit Holder Parking Places) Order 2016 is hereby revoked and replaced with the Schedule to this Order.
3. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of, any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 by or under any other enactment.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
5. The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order

SCHEDULE

In relation to the parking places referred to in this schedule the expression 'permitted hours' means the period between 8.00am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday. Parking places in respect of which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid residents or visitors permit for ZONE E or a valid special or exemption permit.

1. Eldon Avenue (west side)	From a point approximately 1 metre south of the common boundary between property numbers 6 and 7 Hillary House, Eldon Avenue north-westwards for a distance of 10.7 metres
2. Eldon Avenue (East side)	Opposite a point approximately 9 metres south of the southern boundary of property number 5 Hillary House, Eldon Avenue Southwards for a distance of approximately 6 metres
3. Eldon Avenue (East side)	From a point approximately 6 metres south of the northern boundary of property number 8 Eldon Avenue southwards for a distance of approximately 24 metres
4. Eldon Avenue (East side)	From a point approximately 7m north of the northern boundary of property number 11/12 Eldon Avenue northwards for a distance of approximately 5.5 metres
5. Eldon Avenue (East side)	From a point approximately 15 metres north of the northern kerblines of Fairway Avenue junction with Eldon Avenue northwards for a distance of approximately 10 metres
