## **Consultation on Parking – Armstrong Close**

In March 2020 we consulted with residents of Armstrong Close with regard to complaints and concerns received about inappropriate and inconsiderate parking in the area. We have reviewed the responses and the area in question and it has been decided to consult with residents on proposed changes to the waiting restrictions.

We previously proposed waiting restrictions (single yellow line) that stop parking for a specific period (11am – 1pm). This will stop all vehicles (apart from Blue Badge holders) parking at the marked locations. It will also stop inappropriate parking at the junction and bends in the road.

The council is not aiming to make the road exclusive residents' parking area as most properties do have access to one or two off-street parking facilities and spaces available for visitors or tradesmen to park, we are now proposing to prevent obstructing the pavements, junctions and the bends by way of introducing 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at the locations highlighted in the attached map.

Given the major parking issues relates to inappropriate parking at the bends, blocking pavements and at the junctions, 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (Double yellow lines) will be implemented where affected most and as legally required.

This will have the desired effect of improving road safety; improve access for emergency vehicles and essential services vehicles in line with the Highway Code.
