Statement Of Reasons for Proposing

THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (CLARENDON ROAD and MALDEN ROAD, BOREHAMWOOD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

Hertsmere Borough Council is proposing to improve amenity and prevent congestion by introducing new waiting restrictions at the junction of Malden Road and Clarendon Road, Borehamwood as specified in the Schedule to the above-mentioned Order.

The proposal comprises the following:

- At the junction of Clarendon Road and Malden Road 'no waiting at any time' restrictions are being proposed at the corner to prevent inappropriate obstructive parking creating restricted manoeuvrability and access to Clarendon Mews.

These proposals follow requests from local residents and subsequent reviews of on-street parking arrangements and the changes are necessary in order to improve manoeuvrability and access and to improve the amenity for residents. Hertsmere Borough Council considers that the measures proposed are necessary and expedient in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The proposal will be subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area, Hertfordshire County Council, the local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, other local organisations and groups and local residents.
