THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (ELDON AVENUE, BOREHAMWOOD)(RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

In order to prevent congestion, obstructive parking, improve traffic flow and road safety and to improve the environment for local residents and others, Hertsmere Borough Council has made the above named Traffic Regulation Orders to implement waiting restrictions and new parking places in parts of Eldon Avenue, Borehamwood, as specified in the Schedules.

The proposals are being drawn to enable the relocation of the barriers enforcing the current prohibition of driving except for pedal cycles near Eldon Avenue junction with Shenley Road.

Sections of the current limited waiting restrictions which operates from Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm on Eldon Avenue between junctions with Shenley Road and Fairway Avenue are to be replaced by No Waiting At any time restrictions. New residents and visitors parking bays are to be installed within the vicinity to replace parking bays which will be lost through the introduction of No waiting at Anytime restrictions at other locations on the road.

Consent from the Highway Authority to promote these Orders has been granted.
