

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hertsmere Borough Council, pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangement for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000, proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce disabled persons parking bays to improve the amenities of the roads and its surroundings, provide suitable parking to assist and enable blue badge holders to park close to their home and to reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking.
