Consultation on parking

Following a number of comments and complaints in relation to the proposed introduction of parking controls in nearby roads and inconsiderate parking in your area, the Council is carrying out a consultation to establish if there is a problem and how we can best resolve it.

To gauge the view of all residents who would be affected by any new parking controls or changes, I have enclosed a questionnaire and a pre-paid envelope to allow you have a say as to whether you consider parking controls need to be introduced. I would be grateful if all residents could complete the survey and return it to me no later than **20th December 2018**.

Introduction of controls will only be made if a majority of the affected residents are in favour and the Police and Hertfordshire Highways offer no objection. However, the final decision on whether to proceed with a scheme of parking controls will be based on your responses and a decision by local Councillors.

It is important to note that parking controls cannot create more space but they can reallocate this in favour of residents and make access safer. If it is decided to introduce controls, the Council will need to prepare a detailed scheme, draft and advertise a Traffic Regulation Order.

If it is decided to proceed with parking controls any parking proposals will be based on responses received. Therefore your views are very important. I have enclosed a leaflet called, 'Working for Hertsmere', which I hope will help answer some of your questions and concerns.

I look forward to receiving your response by **20th December 2018**.
