THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (PARK ROAD, RADLETT) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2017

Hertsmere Borough Council proposes to implement waiting restrictions and alter the hours of operation for parking bays in Park Road, Radlett.

The general effect of the orders will be to change the hours of operation of restrictions on parking bays from Monday to Saturday 2pm to 3pm to Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm to maximise parking space availability for local residents and introduce new waiting restriction to enable access into dropped kerbs.

The proposals are considered necessary to prevent obstructive parking and help with the free flow of traffic. Therefore, it appears to the Hertsmere Borough Council that it is necessary and expedient to make the Order in the interests of; avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), for preventing obstructive parking and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Consultation has been carried out with local and County Councillors representing the area, the Highway Authority, the local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, FTA, RHA, other local organisations and local residents. Consent from the Highway Authority to promote these Orders has been granted.
