Statement of Reasons for Proposing

THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS INCLUDING CHACE AVENUE, POTTERS BAR) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

In order to prevent congestion, obstructive parking, improve traffic flow and road safety and to improve the environment for local residents and others, Hertsmere Borough Council propose to implement waiting restrictions in parts of Aston Way, Bowmans Close, Chace Avenue, Chauncy Avenue, Coningsby Drive, Featherstone Road, Forbes Avenue, Margaret Close, Park Avenue, Stamford Close, Tempest Avenue and Wayside as specified in the Schedule to the above mentioned Order.

The proposals are considered necessary to prevent obstructive parking, help with the free flow of traffic, and improve visibility and road safety along junctions and blind spots within the vicinity.

Therefore, it appears to the Hertsmere Borough Council that it is necessary and expedient to make the Order in the interests of; avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), for preventing obstructive parking and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Consultation has been carried out with the Police, Councillors, and the Highway Authority. Consent from the Highway Authority and the police to promote these Orders have been granted.
