- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by 5 p.m. on Thursday 12 December:
  - The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 p.m. on Wednesday 4
    December.
  - To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware, giving reasons that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 p.m. on Wednesday 4 December**.
