The wet side changing rooms do not have floor to ceiling doors and panels.**

2) Has a spy camera or similar equipment been found in any of your changing or showering facilities within the last three years? If so, how many of these incidents have been in the last 12 months? How many were found in facilities that were designated mixed-sex, male-only or female-only? **The Council does not hold this information.**

3) Have holes been found in the cubicle doors or side panels in any of your changing or showering facilities within the last three years? If so, how many have been identified in the last 12 months? How many were found in facilities that were designated mixed-sex, male-only or female-only? **The Council does not hold this information.**
