Please refer to data entered in the above table. By way of explanation of the above entries, I can report that historically, Hertsmere has an infinitesimal number of approaches from 16-24 year olds. The bulk of approaches from this tiny group to our Service is through self-referral, following a family dispute. We often employ the services of a specialised partner organisation to mediate in such instances, and coordinate the return of the young person back home. This approach has repeatedly yielded positive results.

We have had no referral from Public Authorities for 16-24 year olds since the Duty to Refer came into effect.
