Councillors, MPs and Members of European Parliament are elected to represent you. But who are they?

Hertsmere Borough Councillors

Hertsmere is divided into 16 wards and each ward has either two or three councillors. Councillors are elected for a four year term to represent the area and help make decisions about local issues. The next election of Hertsmere Borough Councillors is due to take place on 2 May 2023.

Members' Allowances and Expenses

The council's members' allowances scheme is made under the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and the Local Government Act 2000 and in accordance with the Local Authorities (Members' Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003.


The regulations above allow councils to make a scheme which specifies the amount of allowance payable to members, including travel and subsistence allowances. However, the council must have regard to the recommendation of an independent remuneration panel in setting the allowances.

The allowances payable to councillors in Hertsmere are set by an independent remuneration panel on members' allowances which undertakes to review allowances in accordance with government guidelines.

We are required under the above regulations to publish its scheme of allowances for councillors. Details of our current scheme, as approved by the council on 20 November 2013, are set out below and will apply until the scheme is amended or replaced.


If a member's term of office does not cover the whole of a year, the amount of allowance payable will be proportionate to the actual term served.

Members of Parliament (MPs)

Members of Parliament or MPs are elected in a general election, held every five years or so. Each MP serves in the House of Commons, representing their constituency. The Hertsmere Borough Council area is covered by the MP for Hertsmere.

Members of the European Parliament or MEPs are elected in a European election and serve for up to five years.
