You can only vote in elections if your name is on the register.

If you are not registered to vote and would like to, then you can now [register to vote online](#).

The following people are allowed to vote:


- All British, Commonwealth, Irish and other European Union citizens.
- Crown servants employed outside the United Kingdom.
- Members of HM Forces and their spouses.
- Those aged 18 or over.
- European citizens are allowed to vote.
- Overseas electors.
- Overseas electors are allowed to vote.
