High Street, Bushey Parking Review 2026

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

Hertsmere Borough Council periodically reviews parking arrangements across the borough to identify and address parking issues through the introduction, amendment or removal of parking restrictions where appropriate.

Following the implementation of the Bushey Village residential parking zone (Zone BV), the Council has reviewed the existing parking arrangements within Bushey High Street (currently Zone VB, however this will be renamed Zone HS, to avoid confusion between zones BV and VB.) As part of this review, we are seeking the views of residents and businesses through this informal consultation on the following proposed changes:

Proposed Changes

We are proposing that on-street parking on the High Street should be prioritised for shoppers.

- With the exception of a small area of the High Street which is recognised as residential (bays located outside numbers 8-22), bays would operate as Limited Waiting parking bays (1 hour maximum stay, no return within 2 hours). **This change is intended to improve short-stay parking availability for customers and visitors and prevent long-term parking by resident permit holders directly outside local businesses.**
- Existing bays outside Nos. 8-22 High Street would be amended from shared use bays (limited waiting and residents permits) solely to the use of residents permit bays with HS permits as these are away from shops and clearly meeting residential needs.
- Review permit eligibility within the residential Zone (Zone BV) and increase the permit allocation available to eligible residents where appropriate. This would recognise the other residential properties on the High Street and allow residents from those properties to park in the residential Zone BV given they are prohibited from parking on the High Street.
