NOTICE is given that the Hertsmere Borough Council, (pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council) proposes to make the above named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order seeks to introduce changes in some of our car parks to enable enforcement of restrictions within council owned car parks within the borough. The general effect of the Orders will be to introduce electric charging parking bays in the following car parks -

- Barnet Road car park and Manor Road car park, Potters Bar
- Brook Road car park and Clarendon Road car park, Borehamwood
- High Road (opposite St Peters Church hall) and Kemp Place car park, Bushey
- Newberries car park, Radlett
